Amanda Lane, Castle Rock Police Department

On March 19th Amanda Lane joined us to let us know how the CRPD is handling the growth of the City.

Castle Rock has doubled in size in the last 11 years. This means an increase in Sales Tax to help fund the department. There are currently 110 sworn officers, 5 in the Academy and 12 in field training.

This year's focus is traffic safety. Kids on moto bikes are a prime concern. We do not have any laws regulating helmets and kids don't seem to know the traffic laws—that they are not suppose to drive over 28 miles/hour. This is a problem and causes accidents.

We have 3 drones for 1st responders located on 3 buildings in town. The Outlet Malls are a prime spot for crime. There are 4 undercover cars, 3 full uniform unmarked cars. The other problem area is the Pines Rental Units.

They have a 5 year plan on their website. It is only changed every 5 years. The CRPD is one of the best models for police departments in our state. We are very lucky to have this amazing organization protecting us.
