**Matthew Mundall, Director of Missions, Castle Rock Adventist Hospital**

On April 2, Matthew Mundall joined us to talk about the changes to Castle Rock Adventist Hospital Community Impact Counsel. Matthew spends 20% of his time as Chaplin and 80% of his time with the community. The hospital has gone to a “Whole Care Ambassador” program for patients, families and employees. There are programs representing the culture and psychosocial aspects of care.

The 5 Whole Care Ambassadors are trying to grow this program. There are hospitality visits every day with patients to check on their health and connect patients with pastors if they like. There is an Angel Paws program with 2 dogs visiting each day. Programs have grown 103% from 2025. They are working on ways to help patients and families after they leave the hospital. There are 200 volunteers working in the hospital each day which is the largest group in all 5 Adventist Hospitals.

The Community Impact Council is now supporting Mental health, Food insecurity and substance abuse. They want to partner with groups such as Kiwanis who are involved with these same initiatives. They plan on partnering with us in future projects.

We truly appreciate being able to reconnect with Castle Rock Adventist Hospital and Matthew to make a bigger impact in our community.



Chuck Attardo from CDOT joined us again at our April 16th meeting. He brought us up to date on the Crystal Valley Interchange. This should be done in the summer of 2027.

They are working on the US85 Meadows Parkway to Salida project. The plan is to widen it to 4 lanes but land is the problem with Cherokee Ranch and the Railroad right of way.

There will also be work on the I-25 Happy Canyon Interchange to accommodate all of the new growth in that area.
